

Diversity of Job Sector Mirrors Varied Skills of Refugees





- San Francisco State University urban studies professor, Raquel Pinderhughes, identified 22 sectors for green-collar work, ranging from bicycle repair and public transit to renewable energy generation and sustainable agriculture.
- 85% of green business owners and managers thought it would be possible for workers with minimal job experience to get green jobs with their businesses, and that they'd be willing to hire low-income, job-ready workers.
